Annual Clark-McClure Scholarship Procedure

- 1. January: Scholarship announced and applications available.
- 2. March 10th: Scholarship application deadline.
- 3. March/April: Clark-McClure Scholarship Committee selects the scholarship winners and records via the Committee minutes.
- 4. May: Committee sends a letter to each recipient to notify them of their selection on or before May 15th. The student is responsible for providing a tuition bill or official document from the university to the church office.
 This document should include your student ID number.
- 5. August: Committee verifies pending enrollment for fall semester.
- 6. August: Committee directs distribution of funds directly to College.
